## GAMECOCK NOTABLES

- Today marks the Gamecocks' eighth time in the SEC Tournament Championship Game with six titles in their previous seven trips. The vaunted signing class of 2019 has played in the title game every year.
- South Carolina and Tennessee are tied 3-3 in their six all-time meetings in the SEC Tournament. Today is their second meeting in the title game.
- South Carolina has gotten off to quick starts this week, outscoring its opponents $24.5-15.5$ per first quarter. The Gamecocks enjoyed a +6.0 edge in the second quarter over the last two games.
- The Gamecock bench has scored 40.0 points per SEC Tournament game so far, accounting for 46.2 percent of the offense.
- Senior Laeticia Amihere is thriving in every part of the game in Greenville this week. She leads the team with 16.5 points per game on 56.5 percent shooting to go with 5.5 rebounds per game. Against Ole Miss, she matched her career high with seven assists and swatted away three blocks.
- Kamilla Cardoso and Aliyah Boston are both averaging double-doubles at the tournament. Cardoso is the team's second-leading scorer this week with 13.0 points per game to go with her 10.0 rebounds per game. Boston comes in at 10.5 points and 10.5 rebounds per tournament game
- Boston broker her second 40-year old school record of the season when she eclipsed Sheila Foster's total rebounds record on Saturday. Boston's 1,432 career boards are the fifth-best mark in SEC history. With a pair of blocks yesterday, she also moved into a tie with Sylvia Fowles for seventh in SEC history with 321 career blocks.

## A Perennial Power

South Carolina women's basketball is in the midst of its most successful era, claiming at least 20 wins for the last 12 seasons, including six 30 -win seasons in the last nine campaigns. The Gamecocks have played in the NCAA Final Four four times in the last seven NCAA Tournaments, including winning the 2017 and 2022 National Championships. They have been ranked in every AP Poll since Dec. 10, 2012, including a top-10 spot every week since the start of the 2019-20 season. The Gamecocks have amassed 61 AP No. 1 rankings all-time, the fourthmost by a program in the history of that poll., with a current streak of 36 weeks, which is the tied for the second-longest streak in the poll's history. In the 73 polls since the start of the 2019-20 season, South Carolina has been atop the poll 49 times.

Under head coach Dawn Staley's leadership, eight Gamecocks have earned All-America status, three have earned SEC Player of the Year honors and 18 have picked up All-SEC recognition at least once. Nine Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last seven years, including 2018 No. 1 overall pick A'ja Wilson, who went on to become the Gamecocks' second-straight WNBA Rookie of the Year (2018) and the program's first WNBA MVP (2020, 2022).

## The Tennessee Series

While the Lady Vols lead the overall series 49-11, that margin is just 12-10 since the beginning of the Dawn Staley era (2008-09). The Gamecocks have won six of the last seven meetings and nine of the last 13.

The Gamecocks and Lady Vols are tied 3-3 all-time in SEC Tournament meetings with the Gamecocks winning the last three. The most recent was a 67-52 South Carolina victory in the 2021 semifinals en route to their most recent tournament title. South Carolina's first SEC Tournament title came at the expense of Tennessee with the top-seeded Gamecocks posting a 62-46 win over the second-seeded Lady Vols in the 2015 tournament in North Little Rock, Ark.

In this season's earlier meeting, played just 10 days ago in Knoxville, South Carolina overcame a slow start with a pair of strong defensive quarters in th middle of the game to take a 73-60 victory and clinch their seventh SEC Regular-Season Championship.

## SEC Tournament Take

South Carolina is 30-25 all-time in the SEC Tournament since joining the league for the 1991-92 season. Head coach

## TEAM THEME: DNA

South Carolina's 2022-23 season theme "DNA" stands for Dreams, Nets, Assets - the elements routed in the DNA of the program.

Head coach Dawn Staley has described herself as a dream merchant as much as a coach throughout her career. Nets are the symbol of basketball success. Assets is a reminder of each team member's ability to positively impact the team's success as well as nod to the student-athlete's value in the name, image, likeness space.

Staley's program develops a different theme each season to amplify the team's goals and mindset for the season ahead.

Dawn Staley is 27-8 in the event with six championships, all coming in the last eight years.

The Gamecocks have reached the tournament championship game eight times. With titles in 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018, South Carolina is the only program in league history to win four consecutive SEC Tournament title, and the Gamecocks added two more titles in 2020 and 2021.

Aliyah Boston leads the current team in SEC Tournament production at 14.4 points and 11.5 rebounds per game. She was part of the event's All-Tournament Team twice $(2021,2022)$ and was named MVP in 2022.

## Neutral Stance

The Gamecocks are 157-95 (.623) all-time on a neutral court. South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley is 74-27 in games played at neutral sites (.733), including a 46-16 (.742) mark in postseason play.

## Ranked Readings

Against ranked teams, South Carolina is 105-66 (.614) in the Dawn Staley era (beginning 2008-09), and even that mark is skewed by the early seasons of her tenure.

Since the start of the 2014-15 campaign, the Gamecocks are 90-27 (.769) against ranked teams, including a 42-6 mark (.875) since the start of the 2019-20 season.

Senior Aliyah Boston has thrived in her 48 career games against ranked opponents, averaging 15.4 points, 12.3 rebounds and 2.8 blocks while shooting 53.5 percent. Senior Zia Cooke's offense is not far behind with her 13.9 points per game in those 48 outings, including a career-

best 15.3 average in this season's six games.
This season, South Carolina is 6-0 against ranked teams, winning those games by an average of 18.8 points with a +18.3 rebounding margin. Boston leads the way with 16.8 points, 11.7 rebounds and 2.0 blocks per game.

South Carolina's six wins over ranked opponents are the fourth most in the nation this season, and its three true road wins over ranked opponents are second.

Three other opponents on the Gamecocks' schedule are receiving votes in both polls - Tennessee (W, 73-60) Ole Miss (W, 64-57 ot; W, 80-51) and South Dakota State (W, 62-44).

## Ranking Review

The Gamecocks opened this season atop both the AP and the USA Today/WBCA Coaches' Polls for the third time in as many seasons and remained there this week.

In the AP Poll, the Gamecocks' 61 total weeks at No. 1 are the fourth most of any program in that poll's history (third place 83, La. Tech) and their current 36-week streak in that spot is tied for the second-longest in the polls' history (La. Tech). South Carolina has appeared in each of the last 204 AP Polls, which dates back to Dec. 10, 2012, giving it the third-longest active streak in the nation and 12th longest all-time,

In the USA Today/WBCA Coaches' Poll, South Carolina has been in the top 10 since claiming the No. 10 spot in the 2019-20 preseason poll. It has been No. 1 in that poll 46 times in the last nine seasons.

## The Staley File

In her 23 rd season as a head coach, Dawn Staley has a .755 (569-185) winning percentage, which ranks 11th in the nation among active head coaches with at least 10 seasons of experience and ninth among those with at least 20 years in the position. The unanimous 2020 National Coach of the Year, she became the first person to win both a Naismith Player of the Year and a Naismith Coach of the Year and the first Black head coach to win multiple national championships in men's or women's basketball.


In her 15th season leading the Gamecocks, Staley is the program's all-time winningest coach (397) with a programrecord 11 postseason appearances (10 NCAA/1 WNIT). She accounts for all four of the Gamecocks' Final Four appearances $(2015,2017,2021,2022)$ and the first NCAA National Championships in program history $(2017,2022)$.

After claiming seven SEC regular-season titles, Staley has won 183 SEC games, the most among active league coaches and third all-time - trailing just Women's Basketball Hall of Fame inductees Andy Landers (Georgia, 273) and Pat Summitt (Tennessee, 306). Her 12.2 SEC wins average per season is the best in league history among coaches with more than two years in the league, and her 769 SEC winning percentage (183-55) is second only to Summitt (.874) in league history.

In careers affected by the COVID-19 pandemic, the group has reached the Final Four in both their NCAA Tournament appearances, including winning the 2022 National Championship, and has never been ranked outside the top 10. With a combined 124-8 record, they have won 93.9 percent of their games, including a 42-6 mark (.875) against nationally ranked opponents.

In SEC action, the class lost just three league games en route to three regular-season titles (2020, 2022, 2023) in their careers. They are playing in their fourth SEC Tournament championship games, claiming the title in two of the previous three $(2020,2021)$.

## Awards Season

SEC Regular-Season Champion South Carolina also had the most players recognized by the league's coaches in program history and matched its record for most "of the Year" awards in a season.

Aliyah Boston led the way, repeating as SEC Player of the Year and making it a career sweep with her fourth SEC Defensive Player of the Year award and fourth appearance on the All-SEC First Team. She is just the third Gamecock all-time to make an All-SEC team all four times and the second to make the first team every year.

Zia Cooke joined her on the All-SEC First Team, her third All-SEC selection and second time on the first team.

Kamilla Cardoso earned her first SEC postseason awards, claiming Sixth Woman of the Year honors and a spot on the All-SEC Second Team.

Brea Beal on the All-Defensive Team and Raven Johnson on the All-Freshman Team gave South Carolina five players with awards, besting the four total players honored by SEC coaches in 2014, 2015 and 2020.

Dawn Staley picked up her sixth SEC Coach of the Year recognition, giving the Gamecocks four "of the Year" awards, which matched the 2014 and 2015 team's total.

## Rebounding Roundup

South Carolina is routinely among the top rebounding teams in the country and has not dropped off this season.

The Gamecocks rank among the nation's top two in rebounding margin (1st, +21.0 ), rebounding average (2nd, 49.9) and offensive rebounds (2nd, 18.1). South Carolina is securing 43.9 percent of its own missed shots, which leads the nation and has delivered 19.3 second-chance points per game.

South Carolina has been out-rebounded just once this season (41-47 at \#2/2 Stanford, Nov. 20) and only four other games have had a single-digit rebounding margin. The Gamecocks' 74 rebounds against Arkansas were a program record for SEC games, and their +57 rebounding margin (74-17) was a program record and the highest by an NCAA Div. I team in the last 20 seasons.

Aliyah Boston and Kamilla Cardoso are two of the top three rebounders in the SEC. Boston is second in rebounding average (9.7, 28th in NCAA) and third in offensive boards per game (3.5, 30th in NCAA). Cardoso is third in rebounding average 8.9 and second in offensive boards at 3.7 (22nd in NCAA).

## Dial Up the Defense

Head coach Dawn Staley has always put a premium on defense, but the Gamecocks have taken it to another level over the last four seasons (2019-20 to present), during which opponents have scored just 53.8 points per game with 48 of those 132 games ( 36.4 percent) coming against ranked opponents.

This season, South Carolina is third in the nation in scoring defense ( 50.9 ppg ) and second in field goal percentage defense (.312), while leading the country in blocks per game (9.2). Out-scoring opponents by 30.8 points per game, the Gamecocks also lead the nation in scoring margin. That margin includes a +26.4 advantage in SEC games and +18.8 mark against ranked opponents.

No team has reached its scoring average against the Gamecocks this season with the closest being against Kentucky (Feb. 2), which missed its average by 1.2 points. Only three other teams have come within single digits of their average (at \#5/4 UConn, -3.2; Georgia, -4.4; vs. Arkansas, -7.2).

On the season, opposing teams have been held an average of 20.5 points below their usual points per game, including a 17.7 average in SEC games.

The Gamecocks held their six ranked opponents 20.2 points below their average, including \#2/2 Stanford, which scored 20 fewer than its average despite the game going into overtime.

## Paint Production

South Carolina's paint dominance predates the 2019 signing class, but the Gamecocks have certainly perfected it since the group's arrival, scoring 53.7 percent of their points in the paint since the start of the 2019-20 season.

The 2019-20 team had the highest final paint points average (42.4 ppg) in this stretch, but the 2020-21 team posted the highest percentage of paint points (.551).

So far this season, the Gamecocks are posting 45.5 points per game in the paint, which accounts for 55.8 percent of their offense.

Defensively, South Carolina controls the paint as well, allowing opponents to shoot just 36.7 percent in the lane to average 22.3 points in that area. The Gamecocks have been out-scored in the paint just three times this season at \#2/2 Stanford (40-36), at Mississippi State (32-28) and at
\#5/4 UConn (42-38).

## "O" - That's Good!

While retaining its sterling reputation as a defensive stalwart, South Carolina's offense is clamoring for its share of the spotlight this season. The Gamecocks are sixth in the nation in scoring offense ( 81.7 ppg ) and 13th in field goal percentage (.471). Both numbers top those of the program's 2022 National Championship team (70.9, .426).

South Carolina has shot at least 50.0 percent in a game 13 times this season, including three games over 60.0 percent. Last season's National Championship team hit the 50.0 percent mark just seven times all season.

Four Gamecocks are shooting at least 50.0 percent from the field with Aliyah Boston's 56.9 percent accuracy ranking 22nd in the nation and second in the SEC.

## Block Party

South Carolina annually ranks among the best shot blocking teams in the country and leads the way again this season at 9.2 blocks per game..

This season, the Gamecocks have blocked 20.9 percent of their opponents' 2-point attempts, which also leads the country. They have posted double-digit blocks 11 times, led by 16 against Coastal Carolina (Dec. 21).

Three Gamecocks are among the SEC's top 15 - Aliyah Boston (3rd, 2.1), Kamilla Cardoso (4th, 1.9) and Laeticia Amihere (15th, 1.1). Boston's average includes an SEC-best 2.3 in league play.

## Quarter Breakdown

South Carolina's defense has held an opponent to single digits in a quarter 32 times this season. The Gamecocks have out-scored their opponent by 15 or more points in a quarter 22 times. The scoring differential is largest in the second quarter (+8.6).

Individually, eight Gamecocks have scored double digits in a single quarter - Zia Cooke (6), Aliyah Boston (4), Kamilla Cardoso (4), Sania Feagin (3), Laeticia Amihere (1), Talaysia Cooper (1), Kierra Fletcher (1) and Ashlyn Watkins (1). The top single-quarter individual scoring this season is 15 points by Cooke in the fourth at Georgia (Jan. 2).

## Bench Mob

South Carolina's depth has been a hot topic this season, and it has not disappointed.

Averaging 92.9 minutes per game, the Gamecock bench has been especially productive offensively, averaging 37.3 points to account for 45.6 percent of the Gamecocks' total offense and nearly outscoring opponents' starters on the season (38.6). By comparison, last season's bench netted just 21.1 points per game for 29.8 percent of the offense.

Only four opponents' benches have out-scored South Carolina's this season - South Dakota State (Dec. 15, 1915), at Georgia (Jan. 2, 21-19), at Ole Miss (Feb. 19, 17-15), Georgia (Feb. 26, 29-24). The Gamecock bench has tied or out-scored an opponent's starters 13 times and has tied or out-scored its own starters 10 times.

The bench's offensive production has come in key games with this season's group averaging 34.0 points against ranked opponents ( 41.5 percent), including some timely buckets in tight games, and 32.8 points in SEC play (41.0 percent).

On the boards, the bench has grabbed 51.8 percent of the season's rebounds ( 23.4 per game). Kamilla Cardoso leads that group with her 8.9 boards per game, which ranks her third in the SEC.

## The Long and Short of It

With 10 Gamecocks standing 6-feet or taller, South Carolina's roster is among the tallest in the country. The 14 Gamecocks range from 5-foot-8 (Raven Johnson, Olivia Thompson) to 6-foot-7 (Kamilla Cardoso).

South Carolina's 14 players stand an average of 72.9 inches tall, which is second only to Kansas State's 73.1inch average. Stanford is next in line at 72.7 inches with Tennessee coming in at 72.1.

## Beyond Basketball

South Carolina posted a 3.011 GPA in the Fall 2022 semester, the program's eighth-straight semester with a 3.00 or higher mark. In addition to Dean's List entires Brea Beal and Aliyah Boston (the 2022 CoSIDA Academic AllAmerica Team Member of the Year), who exceeded a 3.5 GPA for the semester, eight other Gamecocks made the Athletics Director's Honor Roll ( 3.0 or higher) in the Fall.

Two Gamecocks were named to the CSC Academic All-District Women's Basketball Team this season. Aliyah Boston and Bree Hall are now in the running for Academic All-America honors.

## Boston's Best

Repeat SEC Player of the Year and reigning National Player of the Year Aliyah Boston continues to live up to that title thanks to the flattery of opposing coaches who create defensive schemes expressly designed to slow her down.

Spoiler Alert: It hasn't really worked. According to Her Hoop Stats, among those playing at least 20 minutes per game, Boston is the only player in the country ranked in the top five in both player defensive rating $(5$ th, 68.3$)$ and player offensive rating (4th, 135.3) and leads the SEC in both categories.

Despite the extra attention - double, triple and the occasional quadruple team - the program's career doubledoubles record holder (80) is sixth in the nation with 20 this season. She leads the Gamecocks in rebounding (9.8, 2nd in SEC, 28th in nation) and is second in scoring (13.2) - both numbers that go up dramatically against ranked opponents ( $16.8 \mathrm{ppg} / 11.7 \mathrm{rpg}$ ). Defensively, she remains locked in, ranking third in the SEC and 22nd in the nation with 2.1 blocks per game, including an SEC-best 2.3 per conference game.

From her college debut triple-double in November 2019 to her sweep of the national player of the year awards - including Naismith Defensive Player of the Year the 6 -foot-5 St. Thomas, U.S.V.I., native has been among the best in college women's basketball throughout her career.

Boston is a three-time All-American, three-time winner of the Lisa Leslie Award, four-time SEC Defensive Player of the Year and two-time SEC Player of the Year. In addition to double-doubles, she holds South Carolina career records for total rebounds $(1,432)$, offensive rebounds (501), defensive rebounds (931), consecutive games started (21), rebounds in SEC games (729), offensive rebounds in SEC games (244), defensive rebounds in SEC games (485), blocks in SEC games (165) and double-doubles in SEC games (41). She is also seventh among the program's alltime scorers with 1,868 points. Her program-record 1,432 rebounds are fifth in SEC history, and her 321 blocked shots are second in program history and tied for LSU's Sylvia Fowles for seventh in the SEC

A model of consistency, Boston has scored in double figures 113 times in her 132 career games (.856). Averaging a double-double for her career ( $14.2 \mathrm{ppg} / 10.8 \mathrm{rpg}$ ), she leads all active NCAA players, all divisions, in career doubledoubles and rebounds. Her 321 career blocked shots are second among all active players. She is the SEC's leading active scoring and rebounding leader.

In 48 career games against ranked opponents, her averages rise to 15.4 ppg and 12.3 rpg with 34 doubledoubles in those 48 games (.708).

All that said, Boston's impact on the Gamecocks goes

beyond her own numbers. A three-time team captain, the senior is a constant communicator on the court and off it as well, keeping teammates organized on both sides of the ball and throughout the week.

## Cooke-ing Time

Two-time first-team All-SEC guard Zia Cooke has been mentioned among the best players in the country throughout her career, but the senior has been working toward a year that sees her physical talents meet the mental side of the game, and it appears 2022-23 is that season with her career-best field goal percentage (.407, 12th in SEC) and points per 40 minutes (22.9).

Cooke is the Gamecocks' top scorer with 15.0 points per game (12th in SEC), has led the team in scoring 14 times and scored in double figures 25 times through 31 games. In SEC action, she turned it up another notch, pouring in 17.0 points per game to rank sixth in the league and shooting 43.4 percent, which is 10 th.

Efficiency has been the key for Cooke, who has shot at least 50.0 percent from the field 13 times, including seven SEC outings. Against \#-/22 Arkansas (Jan. 22), she hit a sterling 72.7 percent from the field (8-of-11), including 4-of5 from 3-point range, and repeated the overall shooting performance against Florida (Feb. 16), hitting 5-of-7 from beyond the arc.

Even with her increased scoring, Cooke has been distributing the ball well, too, ranking third on the team in assists (2.1 per game). With her own 15.0 points per game and teammates scoring 4.7 points per game off her assists,

she has had her hands on 24.1 percent of the Gamecocks' offense this season. Against ranked opponents, she's touching 26.3 percent of the offense ( $15.3 \mathrm{ppg} / 6.2 \mathrm{ppg}$ ) and, in SEC play, the number goes up again to 26.6 percent (17.0 ppg / 4.3 ppg ).

## It's Time to BRea-I

Often mentioned by head coach Dawn Staley as irreplaceable, senior guard Brea Beal is finally catching some of the spotlight usually reserved for her stat-performing teammates, including being a semifinalist for Naismith Defensive Player of the Year and earning a spot on the SEC All-Defensive Team.

Beal is second on the team in assists (2.5), third in rebounds (4.1) and fourth in blocks (1.1). Offensively, her timely shooting has been critical to several victories and includes a team- and career-high 39.5 percent accuracy from 3-point range (32-of-81), including 16-of-43 (.372) in SEC action.

Among active SEC players, Beal ranks fifth in career rebounds at 653, second among guards. She is eighth in blocked shots (105), the highest ranking guard on the list.

The powerful guard's trademark defense has not diminished this season. According to Synergy, Beal's matchup has scored just 4.3 points per game on 22.5 percent shooting this season. She has yielded double-digit points just twice this season (UCLA, Nov. 29; Miss. State, Jan. 8) and has posted eight shutout games, including three in SEC action. Per Her Hoop Stats, Beal is among the top 30 in the nation in player defensive rating.

## Vamos Kamilla!

SEC Sixth Woman of the Year Kamilla Cardoso has returned to the form and aggressive play that made her a star in the ACC as a freshman. After a summer during which she spent extended time with her family, the 6-foot7 center returned to Columbia this fall with a renewed energy and passion for the game that has elevated her to the All-SEC Second Team.

Cardoso is second on the team and third in the SEC in rebounding at 8.9 per game, including 3.7 on the offensive end (2nd in SEC, 22nd in nation). Her 1.9 blocks per game are fourth in the SEC (29th in NCAA) and includes 1.9 blocks per league game, which ranks second. Offensively, she is third on the team with 9.9 points per game, including 12.7 points per game against ranked opponents. Cardoso has eight doubledoubles this season, including four in SEC action.

The Brazilian has scored 31.2 percent of her points on putbacks ( 3.1 ppg ). Against ranked opponents, that number rises to 38.2 percent - 4.8 of her 12.7 ppg in those games.

According to Her Hoop Stats, Cardoso is third in the nation in offensive rebounding percentage (.215) and in total rebounding percentage (.246). Both percentages are career highs.

## That's So Raven

SEC All-Freshman point guard Raven Johnson is a dynamic change of speed off the bench whose competitive fire and court vision affect the game on both sides of the ball. Staley lauds Johnson's instincts, court vision and ability to handle the big stage.

Playing just 17.6 minutes per game, Johnson leads the team in steals (1.1) and assists (3.4, 8th in SEC). Her 2.40 assist-to-turnover ratio is 13th in the nation. (2nd in SEC). Her turnovers have out-numbered her assists just six times this season and never by more than one.

Johnson has handed out five or more assists 10 times this season, including four games of her career-high seven assists. The most recent of those came in a 36 -minute outing at \#5/4 UConn (Feb. 5), during which she had no turnovers.

## LA Live

Senior Laeticia Amihere has the size, strength, agility and basketball IQ to play every position on the floor and is the most versatile player she has ever coached, according to Dawn Staley. With a treasure trove of international experience - including playing in the 2020 Tokyo Olympics - the 6-foot-4 Canadian is a dynamic player with unwaivering confidence.

Averaging 7.2 points per game (fourth on the team), Amihere's 48.8 percent shooting is a career high. She is has blocked 1.1 shots per game while also handing out 1.4 assists per game. Amihere has seven double-figure scoring games this season off the bench, including 10 points at \#17/18 Maryland (Nov. 11) and 11 at Kentucky (Jan. 12) with nine of those points coming in the decisive fourth quarter.

## First Gamecock Takes Flight

Freshman Ashlyn Watkins became the first Gamecock in program history to dunk when she slammed one home following a steal with 3:30 to play in the fourth quarter at Clemson (Nov. 17). The Columbia, S.C., native was less hyped than her teammates after a high school career that frequently included that shot selection. Nevertheless, she entered the Gamecock history books fittingly against the program's in-state rival.

## Great Gamecock Fans

South Carolina fans have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last eight seasons and that streak looks to continue for another year with a current 13,308 attendance average.
South Carolina's season-high 18,000 attendance against \#3/2 LSU (Feb. 12) and Georgia (Feb. 26) are the secondhighest marks nationally and the highest for true home games (non-neutral site). Gamecock fans have logged six of the 23 games nationally with at least 13,000 fans, more than any other team.

The Gamecocks have had at least one sellout of their 18,000-seat Colonial Life Arena for seven straight seasons (excluding COVID-limited 2020-21 season) dating back to the first ever sellout of 18,000 on Feb. 8, 2016..

Excluding the COVID limited-attendance season of 2020-21, South Carolina has drawn at least 10,000 fans 107 consecutive regular-season games beginning on Jan. 2, 2015.

South Carolina's 2023 signing class was ranked second in the nation behind the addition of four top-40 players, including a pair of top-20 signings. Chloe Kitts, the \#17 player in the class has already joined the team with her enrollment for the Spring 2023 semester.
